**1) CALL TO ORDER:**

Chair Lord called the public hearing meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

**PROPOSED ORDINANCE #374 – RESTRICTING PARKING ON JACKS MILL DRIVE:**

Mr. Boeckel said over the past several months, the Township and police have been receiving regular complaints about overnight parking along Jacks Mill Drive. These complaints have primarily been about commercial vehicles being parked on the street, sometimes for days at a time. There have also been complaints about these vehicles continuously running refrigeration units and generators. The police have issued tickets for illegally parked vehicles in this area in response to resident complaints.

On-street parking is prohibited along the roadway adjacent to Elksview Townhomes but is permitted from 6 AM to 2 AM along the remainder of the roadway. The “No Parking 2:00 AM to 6:00 AM” restriction was adopted by the Board of Supervisors in July 2009. The minutes of that meeting reflect that the restrictions were meant to curb the parking of commercial and other vehicles along the road. The timeframe of the prohibition, coupled with limited police resources, increases the difficulty of enforcing this regulation.

Proposed ordinance #374 would prohibit parking on Jacks Mill Drive for the entire length of the roadway. Staff has spoken to the management of Centre Estates and Huntington Park apartment complexes about this potential restriction and neither expressed any concerns with the on-street parking prohibition.

There were no comments on Proposed Ordinance #374.

Supervisor Hameister moved to close the public hearing. Supervisor Harden seconded the motion. The public hearing was closed at 7:02 PM.
